Elektromotive Limited launch the first on-street electric vehicle recharging infrastructure onto the streets of London using their Elektrobay system.

Elektromotive has developed the world's first truly generic electric and plug-in hybrid refuelling network. The Elektrobay has been designed as a stylish and durable piece of street furniture that features a standard domestic power outlet to ensure compatibility with all electric vehicle types. The two recharging points are installed in the city of Westminster, it is the first pilot scheme of its type on the UK.

The Westminster Council project has been partly funded by the Transport for London through their Clear Zone initiative and the Energy Savings Trust. It is envisaged that the initial two Elektrobay's in Convent Garden will grow to several hundred recharging points throughout London in the next twelve months, as other London boroughs take the initiative and install the Elektrobay system.

All aspects of this new electric vehicle recharging technology has been designed and manufactured in Sussex.

The Elektromotive transport system is secure and extremely user friendly, offering a safe dedicated power output for existing and future battery technology. This will enable electric vehicle owners to travel throughout the city with easy charging their vehicles at convenient locations and times helping make London a cleaner, quieter, environment to live in.
